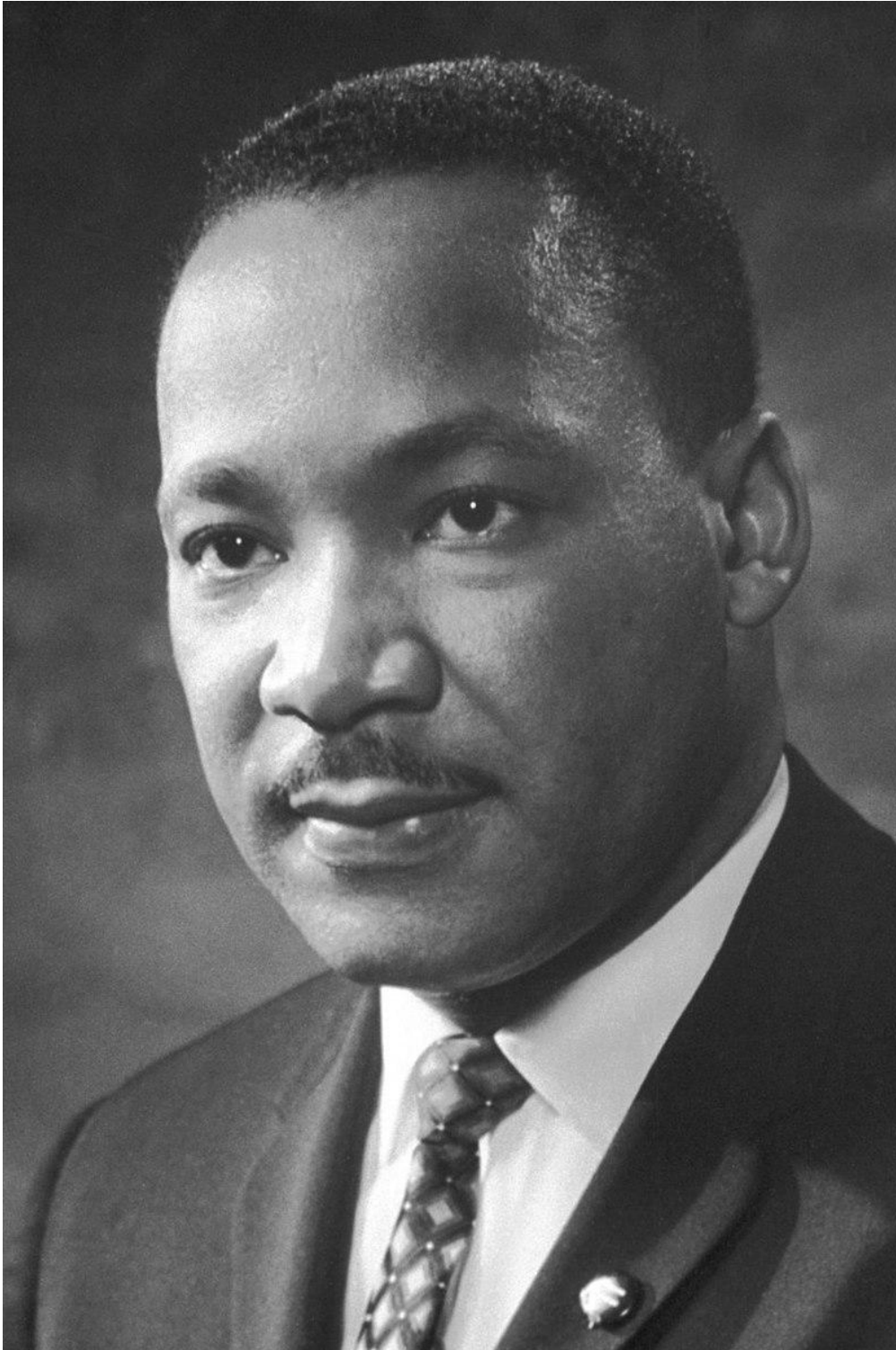


Martin Luther King: A Hero of Equality
